


Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure Azendoo for SSO by using SAML:


- 1. In a browser, type https://app.azendoo.com/auth/sign-in and press Enter.
- 2. Type your Azendoo email address and click **NEXT**.



3. Type your Azendoo password and click **START WORKING**.




4. In the dashboard page, click **Manage subscription**.



- 5. In the **Manage subscription** page, click the **SSO** tab.
- 6. Turn on the **Activate SSO** toggle button.
- 7. Enter the values for the following fields:

Required Information	Description
IDENTITY PROVIDER SINLGE SIGN-ON URL	IdP logon URL
IDENTITY PROVIDER SINLGE LOG-OUT URL	IdP logout URL
IDENTITY PROVIDER ISSUER	Issuer URL

X.509 CERTIFICATE Copy and paste the IdP certificate. The IdP certificate must begin and end with ----Begin Certificate----- and -----End Certificate--- Note: The IdP metadata is provided by Citrix and can be accessed from the link below. - 8. Finally, click **Save**.
- 9. Note down the values for IdP configuration.
