

# Configure Azendoo for Single Sign-On


Configuring Azendoo for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Azendoo by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

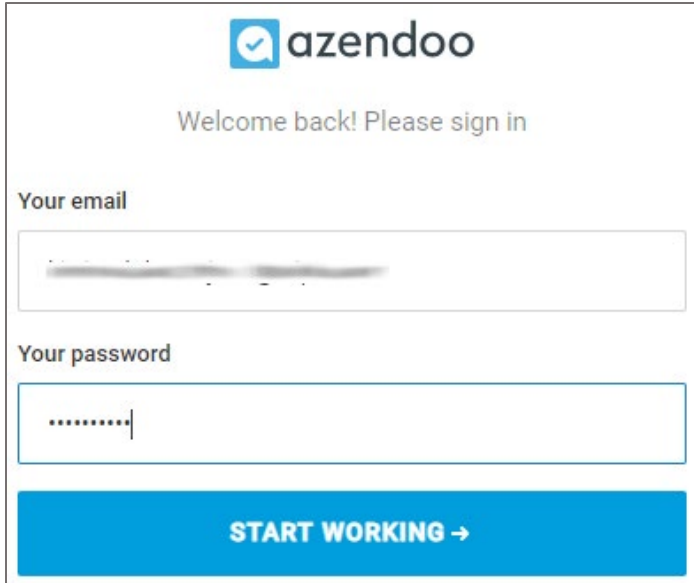
## To configure Azendoo for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://app.azendoo.com/auth/sign-in> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Azendoo email address and click **NEXT**.

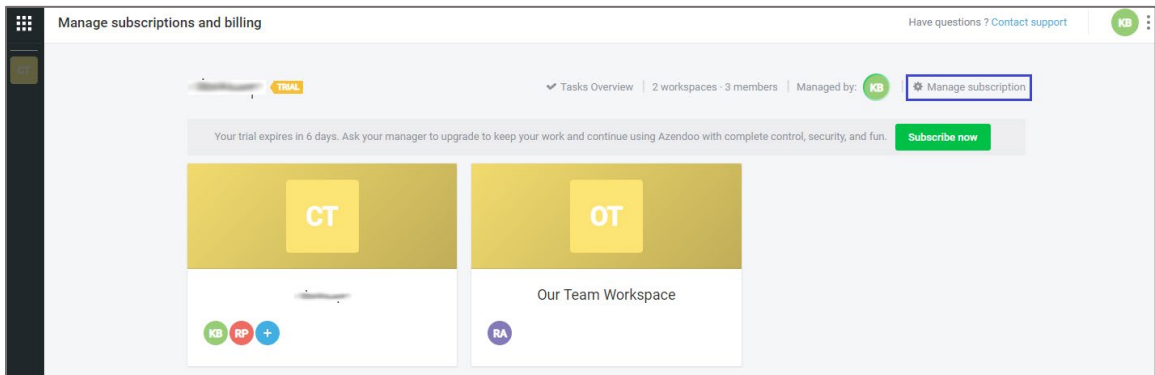

7. Enter the values for the following fields:

Required Information	Description
IDENTITY PROVIDER SINGLE SIGN-ON URL	IdP logon URL
IDENTITY PROVIDER SINGLE LOG-OUT URL	IdP logout URL
IDENTITY PROVIDER ISSUER	Issuer URL
