

# Configure Resource Guru for Single Sign-On

Configuring Resource Guru for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Resource Guru by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite


Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

### To configure Resource Guru for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://resourceguruapp.com/login> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Resource Guru admin account credentials (**Email** and **Password**) and click **Log in**.

3. In the dashboard page, click the user account icon in the top-right corner and select **Settings**.



- In the **SETTINGS** page, click **SSO** in the left pane.

- In the **SSO/SAML (Single Sign On) Configuration** page, click **Configure SSO**.

### SSO/SAML (Single Sign On) Configuration

SSO/SAML enables members of an identity provider (IdP) of your choice to access Resource Guru without having to set up a separate Resource Guru ID (login). Resource Guru's SSO works with any IdP that supports SAML 2.0 including Google G Suite, Microsoft Azure, Okta, Ping Identity, Ping Federate, OneLogin, Bitium, LastPass, Centrify, Clearlogin, Auth0 and many others. **Configure SSO**

- Enter the values for the following fields:

SSO URL/Endpoint*	IdP logon URL
IdP Entity ID*	Issuer URL
IdP X.509 Certificate	<p>Copy and paste the IdP certificate. ## New SSO Configuration

SSO needs to be configured in both your Resource Guru account and your Identity Provider (IdP) account. You will need the following when setting up SSO with your IdP:

- ACS URL: https://[REDACTED].resourceguruapp.com/sso/acs
- Entity ID: resource-guru
